## **Information for Exhibitors**

### ***Welcome to the Twelfth Annual Dighton Arts Festival!***

***Thank you for registering for the 2016 Dighton Arts Festival! Please read the following information carefully before coming to the festival. By following the recommendations and requirements stated below, you can contribute to ensuring that everyone has a safe and enjoyable day at the 2016 Dighton Arts Festival.***

**Festival date and hours:** Sunday, November 6th from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**Location.** The festival will be held at Araujo Farms at 1522 Williams Street in Dighton.

Williams Street is located at the western end of Main Street in Dighton.

Take a right onto Williams Street at the end of Main Street. Araujo Farms is a short distance on the left hand side.

**From Route 44:** Burt Street (Taunton) becomes Williams Street (Dighton) at the American Auto Auction.

- From the east (Taunton), take a left onto Burt Street after the Route 44 entrance to the American Auto Auction
- From the west (Rehoboth), take a right onto Burt Street before the American Auto Auction.

Follow Williams Street a few miles to Araujo Farms on the right.

**Setup time** is from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, November 6th. Exhibitors will unload their vehicles at the rear of the third or fourth greenhouses. Members of the Dighton Lions Club will be available on Sunday morning to assist with carrying items to your exhibit space. In order to ensure the most efficient loading time for exhibitors, please move your vehicle from the rear of the greenhouses as soon as you have finished unloading your exhibit materials to allow other exhibitors access to the unloading area. All exhibitor vehicles must be off the festival grounds and parked as described below by 9:45 a.m. We strongly recommend that you arrive as early as possible. We will not be able to accommodate requests for setup on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Exhibitor parking** will be on the Stronstrom property at 1216 Williams Street – a short distance from the festival. Transportation will be provided to and from the festival site. All exhibitor vehicles must be parked at this location. This arrangement will ensure that all parking spaces at Araujo Farms will be available for festival attendees.

**Exhibit spaces** are 8 feet wide by 10 feet deep. Please note that because of the contour of the greenhouse walls, display panels that are 6 feet high or taller will be located at least two feet from the back of the exhibit space. For example, if your display panel is 6 feet high, your effective exhibit area will be 8 feet wide by 8 feet deep. We suggest in that circumstance that the space behind the panels can be used for storage. Under no circumstances will exhibitors be allowed to extend their exhibit outside the marked area. Adherence to this policy is necessary to ensure the flow of festival attendees through the exhibit area.

**Electricity** will be available at all exhibit spaces.

**Tables/Chairs**. 8-foot tables will be provided to all exhibitors who requested one at the time of registration. Folding chairs will be provided at no charge but feel free to bring one if you prefer.

**Food**. The Dighton Lions will be selling food throughout the day. You may purchase your lunch and other refreshments at the festival or bring your own. Volunteers will come to each exhibitor space around noon to take and deliver orders.

**Comfort**. The greenhouses can become warm on an unseasonably warm, sunny day in the fall. Please dress accordingly. If recent experience is an indication, we suggest being prepared for temperatures in the 70s in the greenhouses when the outdoor temperature is in the upper 50s to low 60s. Each greenhouse has a heating system that will be turned on if needed.

**Sales Taxes**. Collection and payment of Massachusetts sales tax is the responsibility of each exhibitor. No provision has been made for a festival sales tax certificate.

**Breakdown Time**. For the safety of festival visitors and other exhibitors, all exhibitors are expected to remain setup until the end of the festival at 4:00 p.m. At that time, transportation will be provided to your vehicle at 1216 Williams Street.

**Enjoy!** The Dighton Lions Club and Dighton Arts Festival Planning Committee hope you have an enjoyable day and that you are able to take some time during the day to attend the performances as well as view the other exhibits. 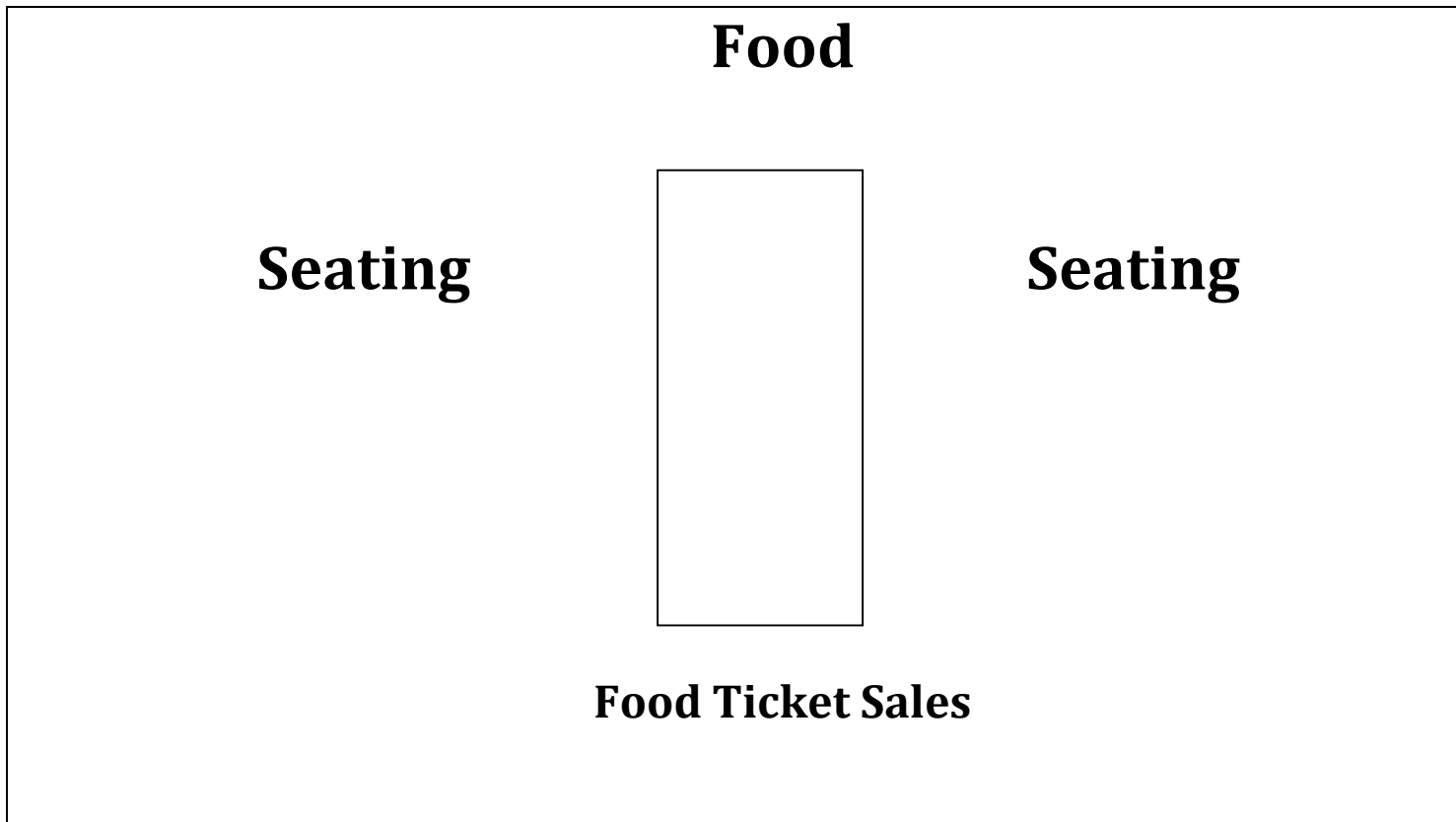
